



# Quick Reference Rates

## Cascade Use Rates

*Species:* **sago pondweed, curlyleaf pondweed and american pondweed**

Multiple of 24 – 32 (1.27 – 1.7 gal/CFS)

*Species:* **horned pondweed, milfoils, naiad, and coontail**

Multiple of 36 (1.91 gal/CFS)

## Teton Use Rates

### Algae:

*Species:* **filamentous algae**

Multiple of 1.2 – 1.8 (0.13 – 0.20 gal/CFS)

*Species:* **chara**

Multiple of 2 – 4 (0.22 – 0.45 gal/CFS)

### Weeds:

*Species:* **sago pondweed, horned pondweed, curlyleaf pondweed, american pondweed, milfoil, naiad, coontail**

Multiple of 6 – 12 (0.67 – 1.35 gal/CFS)

*Species:* **elodea**

Multiple of 12 – 24 (1.35 – 1.80 gal/CFS)

Teton may be toxic to fish when applied at rates greater than 0.30 ppm.
